Postdoc position in high energy phenomenology in Lund, Sweden

The High Energy Physics (HEP) group in the department of Theoretical Physics at Lund University will have a two-year postdoc position available, starting no later than fall 2009.

The HEP group currently consists of three senior scientists, Johan Bijnens, Leif Lönnblad and Torbjörn Sjöstrand, together with one postdoc and six PhD students. The main research areas are high and low energy particle phenomenology with emphasis on the development of Monte Carlo event generator programs, higher-order calculations in chiral perturbation theory and flavour physics. The group is active within the EU-funded networks Flavianet and MCnet, and is running an EU-funded PhD school together with the experimental department of high energy physics in Lund. The applicants are expected to have a PhD in theoretical high energy physics and a background and strong interest in particle phenomenology. They are also expected to be experienced enough to be able to carry out independent research that could broaden the interests of the group.
