Presentation and course grade

The thesis is presented both at a seminar and in a written report. The final grade (väl godkänd – pass with distinction / godkänd - pass / underkänd – fail) is decided by an examination committee, and is determined by assessing the quality of both the work carried out and the presentation. The following criteria are considered:

- Work effort and time planning
- Independence and commitment
(inquisitiveness, ability for independent analyses and conclusions, originality)
- Scientific work (quality, interpretation and assesment of results)
- Written report (structure and clarity)
- Oral presentation
(time planning, structure, communication, ability to answer questions)

The written report should be made available to the committee *at the latest* two weeks before the oral presentation, and must at that time be approved by the supervisor. Approval of the written report by the supervisor and course responsible is required for the oral presentation.
